

PIANO I/II



Course Description

This course is designed to teach students the fundamentals of playing the piano by learning proper playing techniques and mastering music theory skills. Students will have the opportunity to perform piano pieces for the class and gain an understanding of melodic and chordal structure, rhythmic patterns and use of expression in music by focusing on music history, key composers and basic music concepts.



Course Objectives

Students will study basic to intermediate note reading and general characteristics of piano performance., such as posture, technique, and incorporating music elements.

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- Students will apply knowledge of melodic structure • and use of intervals and accidentals in piano performance.
- Students will apply knowledge of harmonic structure and use of chord progressions in piano performance.
- Students will create their own composition using foundational concepts learned throughout the year.


